

House Resolution Number

1 WHEREAS, under the provisions of House Joint Resolution No. 14,
2 the voters of Missouri will decide whether to approve a major bond
3 issue for the construction, renovation, and repair of buildings at
4 state institutions of higher education, as well as other state capitol
5 improvements, maintenance needs, and transportation infrastructure;
6 and

7 WHEREAS, low interest rates and construction costs and the state
8 making final payment on the Third State Building Fund last October
9 make this an ideal time for a major bond issuance; and

10 WHEREAS, the proposed projects to be undertaken will provide many
11 opportunities for job creation and economic growth that will be of
12 immediate and direct benefit to many Missourians; and

13 WHEREAS, there is significant need for the proposed projects
14 across the state; and

15 WHEREAS, it is improvident to list specific construction projects
16 in the constitution; and

17 WHEREAS, respect for the sound judgment of the voters compels us
18 to inform the voters of the projects to the maximum degree practical;
19 and

20 WHEREAS, the voters of Missouri benefit, wherever possible, from
21 transparent and accountable government;

22 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that we, the members of the House of
23 Representatives of the Ninety-seventh General Assembly, First Regular
24 Session, hereby declare that, to the degree possible, the state will
